

CAMPSITE REGULATIONS - MARINA D'ALERIA

I- GENERAL CONDITIONS

1° Admission conditions

To enter, accommodate and stay in the campsite you must have the permission from the manager or his representative. The manager has to ensure the smooth running of the campsite and that the following rules are respected. Staying in the campsite Marina d'Aléria implies that you accept these rules and comply with it.

2° Police formalities

Each person who wants to stay at least one night in the campsite must give the manager or his representative an ID card on arrival and complete all registration formalities at the reception.

Unaccompanied minors will not be admitted.

3° Installation

Tents, caravans and all equipment must be settled on the pitch indicated by the manager or his representative.

Regarding the accommodation in bungalows, please inform the reception in case of any problems or missing item from the inventory list received on arrival.

4° Reception

Information concerning the campsite services, restaurant, sports facilities, local tourist attractions and useful addresses are available at the reception. A suggestion/complaints book or box is available for customers who might need it.

5° Fees

Fees for the bungalow rental are to be paid at least 30 days before arrival. Regarding the campsite, campers have to pay the day before departure if they leave before 9.00am or on the day of the departure if they leave between 9.00am and 12.00 noon. The prices are displayed at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception. You pay according to the number of nights you spent in the campsite or you booked.

6° Noise and silence

Campers must avoid loud talking and disturbing the neighbours by making too much noise. Sound devices must be adjusted accordingly. Car doors and car trunks must be closed as quiet as possible. Dogs and other animals must be kept on leads. It is forbidden to let your animals alone in the campsite if you leave it for the day. You are legally responsible for them. Silence must be respected between 11.00pm and 7.00am.

7° Visitors

According to the authorization from the manager, visitors may enter in the campsite under the responsibility of the campers who invited them. The customer may receive the visitors at the reception. If they are allowed to come in, they have to pay fees in order to use all the facilities in the campsite. Visitors' cars are not permitted in the campsite.

8° Traffic flow and parking

In the campsite, you must drive 10km/h maximum. Traffic is not allowed between 11.00pm and 7.00am.

Regarding late arrivals after 11.00pm you must park your car on the main road and go by feet to your place or your bungalow.

Only people attending the campsite are allowed to drive in it. One must park his car on the dedicated places in order to prevent too much traffic inside the campsite.

9° Respect of the facilities

Each camper has to take care about the cleanliness and the hygiene of the campsite, particularly in the sanitarities. It is not allowed to throw the waste water on the ground or in the gutters. You must empty your waste water in the areas provided. You must wash your stuff (clothes or dishes) in the sinks provided.

Do not damage trees, plants and flowers. It is forbidden to nail something on the trees, to cut branches or to plant anything in the campsite. It is forbidden to bind a pitch in a personal way or to dig the ground. Campers will be charged if any damage is caused to the vegetation, fences or facilities of the campsite. The pitch or the bungalow you rented during your stay must be left clean and without any waste.

10° Safety

a) Fire.

Open fires (wood, charcoal, etc) are strictly forbidden. Barbecue is allowed but you must watch the fire and avoid doing it in dangerous conditions. Please pay attention to the weather - barbecue is forbidden in case of wind. In case of unintentional fire, please inform immediately the campsite manager and call emergency number (18 or 112). Fire extinguishers are available if necessary on several points of the campsite. A first aid box is available at the reception.

b) Theft.

The campsite management is responsible for objects left at the reception and has a global obligation to keep the campsite safe. Campers are responsible of their equipment on their pitch and must inform the management if they notice any suspicious person. Although there is a guard, campers are required to take the usual precautions for the saving of their equipment.

11° Games

Any violent or annoying game must not be organized inside the campsite and close to the facilities. To use the playground and games facilities, children must be accompanied by their parents. Children must respect all the playground areas and wear the access bracelet. In the playground area, children are under their parents' responsibility. The management team is not responsible in case of any accident.

12° Storage

If campers want to leave some equipment in the campsite, they have to ask for the permission at the reception in order to know where they can put it. Please notice that a fee may be applied for this service.

13° Hygiene and behaviour

The sorting of waste is the rule for recyclables and glass. We ask campers to respect it and not to let anything next to the containers.

You must be watchful to turn water taps down and switch off the lights, air conditioning or heating when you leave the accommodation.

14° Display

These rules of procedure are posted on the campsite and at the reception. The reception team can give it to any camper who requires it.

15° Infringement of the campsite regulations

In the case in which any camper disturbs the stay of other campers or does not respect the campsite rules, the manager or his representative can give a formal verbal or written warning to stop the disorder.

If there is a serious or a repetitive infringement of the campsite regulations after the warning by the owner, the management has the right to put an end to the contract. If any camper commits a criminal offence, the management of the campsite may call the police.

I- PARTICULAR CONDITIONS

REGULATIONS FOR THE SWIMMING POOL AREA

Opening time: 10.00am to 6.00pm

Every person who enters the swimming-pool area must wear the access bracelet.

Before getting in the pool, swimmers must go by the foot bath and take a shower.

It is forbidden to enter the area wearing shoes.

The foot bathes must not be used as anything else than foot bathes.

Smoking, chewing-gums, spitting and bringing food and drinks in the area is forbidden.

Animals are not allowed in the swimming-pool area.

Diving and running around the swimming-pool is forbidden.

Air mattresses and balls are not allowed in the swimming-pool area.

SPA is forbidden at babies and child under 16 years old

People who present any skin lesions, without a non-contagious certificate cannot get into the swimming-pool.

Unaccompanied children will not be admitted as they are under their parents' responsibility.

Access to the swimming-pool is likely to be limited for 2 hours per day and per person in case of large crowds. Deckchairs cannot be reserved, any unattended towels or personal stuff will be automatically taken away from the deckchairs.

We ask you to read these rules of procedure.

The management team has the right to forbid the access to the swimming-pool to any person who does not respect these rules.

Please note that the campsite is under video control.
